Learning summary

This learning covers the role of a fire warden. Having a designated fire warden at work is an important part of fire safety. The fire warden works together with the employer to ensure that fire safety measures and evacuation procedures are in place and effective.

Learning aims

The aim of this learning is to provide nominated fire wardens with necessary fire safety awareness, information and understanding to fulfil the requirements of the role of a fire warden.

- Recognise fire hazards and how to prevent fire
- Understand the behaviour of fire inside buildings and the behaviour of people during a fire incident
- Understand how people and buildings are protected from fire and our legal duty to protect ourselves and others
- Be able to respond as a fire warden, to any fire incident or fire alarm and undertake the day-to-day responsibilities of a fire warden, specific to your workplace
