Learning aims	The aim of this learning is to raise awareness of the individual responsibility we have to help keep the workplace safe by following the precautionary measures and procedures put in place. Doing so reduces the hazards present, ensuring that accidents and incidents that can cause serious harm are kept to a minimum.
